New2L Curriculum

Students divided into 6 levels and 3 groups (Basic, Intermediate and Advanced), assigned through placement level testing.

Level 1 (Basic 1)

- Learn the Korean alphabet and its pronunciation structure.
- Acquire skills to understand and utilize basic words and simple sentences.
- Acquire conversational skills for basic day-to-day activities.

Level 2 (Basic 2)

- Learn accurate pronunciation and acquire skills to identify phonetic changes.
- Learn connective and terminating endings, as well as grammar, such as passive and causative expressions.
- Acquire practical speaking skills necessary for daily life.

Level 3 (Intermediate 1)

- Learn vocabulary necessary for basic day-to-day functions such as basic social activities and use of public facilities.
- Learn and master complex passive and causative expressions, auxiliary verbs, etc.
- Master linguistic functions such as description, advice, and refusal, necessary for maintaining social relationships.

Level 4 (Intermediate 2)

- Learn onomatopoeia, mimetic words, proverbs, and basic words related to current events.
- Gain understanding of complex propositions and use of endings, and learn and master their various meanings and uses.
- Discuss basic current events and gain more understanding of Korean culture.

Level 5 (Advanced 1)

- Learn various idioms and loanwords, as well as abstract and current event expressions related to social events.
- Read various current event articles on politics, economics, society, and culture, as well as comparatively easy literary works, and discuss related issues.
- Master linguistic functions such as summarization, debate, and persuasion necessary for the working environment.

Level 6 (Advanced 2)

- Learn a wide variety of terms, slangs, jargons, and abbreviations related to specialized areas.
- Acquire skills to understand abstract content in the areas of politics, economics, society, and culture, as well as philosophy, literature, and ideology.
- Acquire skills to speak about work or specialized topics accurately and fluently, enough for academic enrollment and employment.

Simple Registration Process



- Application : By post mail or in person or by proxy (on a first come, first served basis)
- Qualifications : High School graduates or equivalent

Documents Required

In case of the D-4 VISA, required documents are subject to applicant's nationality.
Check with the ERICA IIE Office about the required documents.

REGULATIONS FOR NEW2L STUDENTS

Placement Test

Applicants must take the placement test to determine their appropriate Korean levels. But first-time learners can apply directly to level 1 class without taking the placement test.

Attendance

Students must maintain 80% or higher attendance rate to complete the New2L: Korean Language Program and to be able to re-enroll for the next semester. Students should give notice to the homeroom teacher when they are late or absent. When students have to leave for a special reasons (i.e. sickness, emergency and so on), they must submit appropriate certificates or documents to excuse an absence.

Evaluation

Students grades are based on attendance, class participation, assignments, and the midterm and final exams.

Scholarships

Scholarships may be awarded to students who excel in their studies and are registered for more than 6 months in the Regular Korean Course in ERICA IIE. Students can receive a 10%, 30%, 50%, or 100% tuition refund according to their academic results.

Re-enrollment

Current students who wish to re-enroll for a course need to submit the re-enrollment application to the ERICA IIE office during the re-enrollment period. Students who attend less than 80% of classes are not allowed to re-enroll. Tuition must be paid and bank receipt must be submitted to the ERICA IIE office. And students can apply for the required documents for extending VISA period from ERICA IIE office.

Refund

- Applicants who are refused the Student VISA (D-4) by the Korean Embassy or Korean Immigration Office will receive a 100% tuition refund. (It will require 2 weeks to process and return to applicants.)
- Applicants who want to get a refund due to personal unforeseen events prior to the start of the semester can apply to do so. Applicants will get refunds according to the refund policy stated below.

Before start of semester	90% tuition refund
Within 1 week of start of semester	80% tuition refund
Within 2 weeks of start of semester	50% tuition refund
2 weeks after start of semester	No refund

* Application fee is not refundable.



STUDENT LIFE FOR NEW2L STUDENTS

VISA

Students applying for the Regular Korean Course at Hanyang University ERICA must apply for the Student VISA at the Korean Embassy after receiving admission from ERICA IIE. Students are responsible for obtaining appropriate VISA for language training. If applicants fail to get VISA after registering at ERICA IIE, student must apply for tuition refund within 2 weeks of the course starting date. Admission letters and tuition receipt will be sent to the applicants applying for VISA in their countries.

Student VISA Extension

In order to extend a student VISA, students must submit the re-enrollment application form to the ERICA IIE office and pay the tuition fee. After payment completion, students will get a certificate of studentship, payment receipt, and transcript from the ERICA IIE office. Aside from these documents, students must prepare their passport, alien registration card, bank deposit certificate (in the student's own name), and certificate of residence for the Korean Immigration Office.

Library

Students can have access to all books and various multimedia materials of ERICA Library with student ID card issued by ERICA IIE Office. However, books cannot be borrowed. For more details, please refer to ERICA Library web site. <http://information.hanyang.ac.kr>

Mentoring Program

At the end of each semester, students can apply for the mentoring program which is designed to provide help through an exchange of language and culture with ERICA university students. Students can apply through their homeroom teacher.

Dormitory

- Applicants can apply for dormitory accommodations after submitting the application documents for the Korean Regular Course. (on first come and first served basis).
- A twin room (shared) - around KRW 10,000 per day (can be changed)
- Payment should be completed according to the payment notice from the administration office of dormitory. Students can check the total amount and payment deadline on the payment notice.

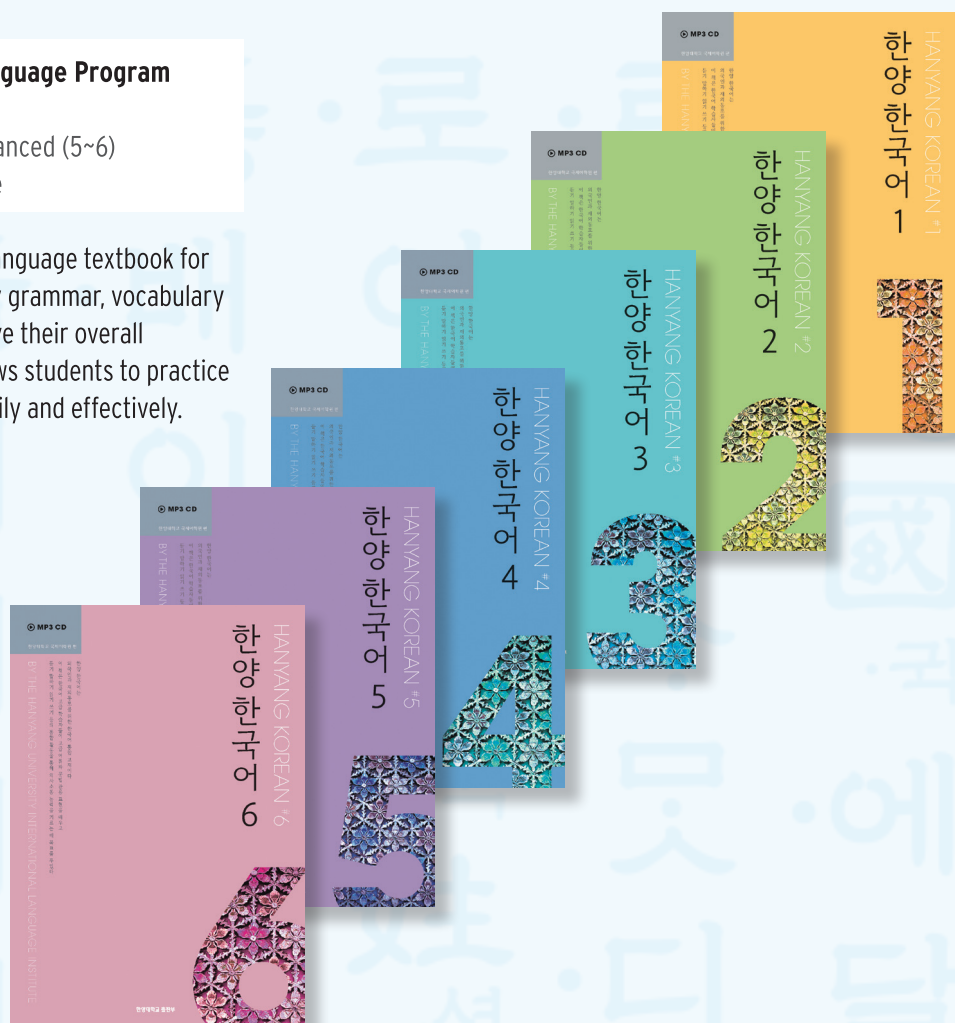
